### Meet the Teacher

Families will have the opportunity to meet their child's new class teacher on the following dates:

Y3 & Y4 (**current Y2 & Y3**) Monday 1st July 2.45pm  
Y5 & Y6 (**current Y4 & Y5**) Tuesday 2nd July 9.00am  
Y1 & Y2 (**current F2 & Y1**) Tuesday 2nd July 2.45pm

Teachers from each year group will be one of the current classrooms and you can enter from the outside classroom door.

### Transition Session

There will be a transition session for your child to get to know their class teacher and to help establish routines ready for the start of September on Tuesday 2nd July, between 10.30am and 2.30pm.

### End of Year Reports and Assessment Data

- On Friday 5th July, your child's assessment data will be sent home (apart from Y6 SATs data which will be sent home on the 9th/10th July when available)
- On Wednesday 10th July between 2.30pm and 4.30pm, there will be a drop in session to see your child's current class teacher to discuss assessment data. Teachers will be in their classrooms and you can enter from outside.
- On Friday 19th July, your child's report and University Folder will be sent home.
