Attendance

Attendance has always been important but through COVID routines changed and attendance across the country has never recovered. Our school target is 96%. Every week we have class competitions to see who gets the highest % and half termly prizes for Watercliffe Thursday Green 'Un Page 1 classes who have the best attendance. There are also individual prizes and Attendance Bronze, Silver and Gold badges are given out in July if attendance is above 96%. This NHS website will help if your child is not

There is clear evidence that children with good attendance, above 96%, achieve more in their school life. This year we have linked attendance at the Y6 Prom to attendance in school. Children below 90% will not be able to attend and letters wer sent out to families of Y6 children letting them know if their child is on track to attend.
