Dear Families of children in Year 2

Year 2 - Two Night Residential Visit 2025

We are excited to offer our Y2 children the chance of a 2 night residential to Whiteley Woods Outdoor Activities Centre. This is owned by the Girlguiding charity and we have used the site now for the last few years. We have booked the Renwick and Plimsoll buildings for two nights **20th to 22nd October 2025**. The total cost for this residential visit is **£55.00** per child. This includes transport, the cost of accommodation and food. This residential visit is limited to 44 places for the entire year group. This is the maximum number of children Whiteley Woods can accommodate. Due to the sleeping arrangements this needs to be 22 boys and 22 girls. Places will be given on a first come first served basis to those who pay the £10 deposit. **Any outstanding debts to school must be paid before a place can be booked. The last day for booking is Friday 26th September with a £10 deposit.**

The easiest way to book your place and pay the £10 deposit is on the School Gateway app. If you are not registered on this please contact school on office@watercliffe.sheffield.sch.uk. The remaining £45 needs to be paid by **Friday 10th October** to keep your place and this can also be done on the School Gateway app.

So that you can find out more about what we have planned we have arranged a meeting after school on **Thursday 18th September at 4:00pm** in the Hall. At the meeting we will provide more details about the visit and give you the chance to ask any questions you may have. If you would like to sit with your child and discuss the residential here is a link to last year's video.
