School Street Update

Many of you will have seen our School Street road closure in place on Boynton Road at drop off and home times over the last few months. This is a Sheffield City Council scheme that we were encouraged to trial due to the number of concerns that were raised by parents and residents regarding dangerous and illegal parking.

We're pleased to say that this is now permanent after a very successful trial period. We'd like to thank you for your overwhelming support of the scheme and to our staff who go out every day whatever the weather!

September has been a busy month with lots of new families joining us. Here's a reminder of how it works:

School Streets is an approach to improve road safety and air quality outside schools, whereby they are closed to traffic at the start and end of the school day. This helps to reduce congestion and improve air quality at the school gates, making it easier and safer to walk or cycle to school whilst creating a more pleasant environment for everyone.

How does School Street work?

- Boynton Road is closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Shirecliffe Road.
- The closure operates Monday to Friday, term time only.
- Closure times are 8:15am to 9:15am in the morning and 2:45pm to 3:45pm in the afternoon.
- During these times vehicular traffic is not allowed to enter Boynton Road via the closure point (exemptions do apply).
- Residents living within the closed section of roads always have access via a permit scheme.

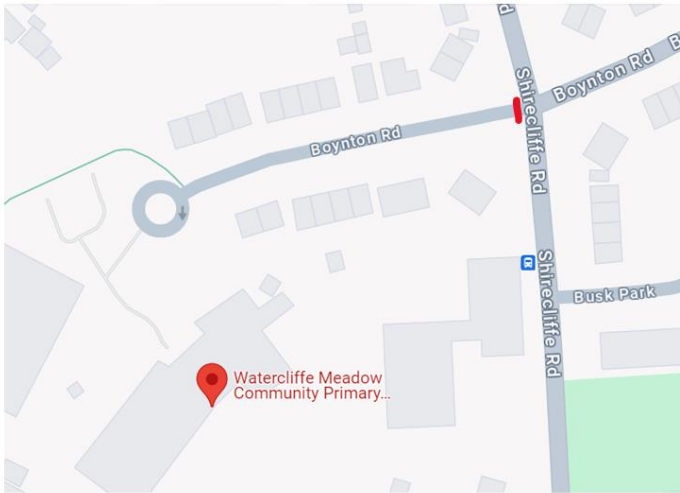

Frequently Asked Questions

“What will I be able to do in these closure times?”

During the closure times ONLY authorised vehicles may enter and leave via the closure point. Parent / Carers driving their children to school do NOT have access to the closed section of Boynton Road.

“What if myself or my child is disabled?”

Blue badge holders will be exempt and just need to present themselves and their badge to the road closure marshal.

“I drive a taxi, am I exempt?”

If you are driving a taxi for work and are picking up or dropping of a resident living within the closed area OR contracted by Sheffield City Council to pick up / drop off children, you will be given access.

“What other parking restrictions are there around school?”

There are various parking restrictions in place on the roads around school and we would ask that you do not park at any of the following locations:

- Junction corners
- Double yellow lines
- Blocking residential or business access
- Bus stops
