## **Christmas Fayre – Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**

Our Christmas Fayre will be held on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December, from 2pm until 4pm.

Once again this year, we are raising money to improve Amy's Garden so children can enjoy this space once again. We're very excited that our plans are progressing but we still are short of funds to complete our grand plan!

You can help us make this event a success in a number of ways:

- Donations of nearly new toys and games (good condition – no jumble please)
- Prizes for the tombola and raffle
- Donations of children's and adult Christmas Jumpers to sell on one of our stalls
- Cakes to sell on our baking stall (please bring these in on the day)
- If you know of any companies that would be prepared to support our raffle and donate a prize, it would be greatly appreciated
- If you can spare us the time to help on a stall, or set up, please see Rachel in the office

This event will be held inside, and so to try and make sure school is not too crowded, we are giving parents and carers the opportunity to take their children out of class early:

- Y3 and Y4 - collection can be from 2.30pm
- Y5 and Y6 - children will finish at the usual time at 3.15pm

## Tokens

Following the previous success of tokens, we will be using tokens again at the Christmas Fayre.

### How will it work?

- If you want to be organised and buy your tokens in advance, you can do this via the School Gateway app, from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> November. **Due to long queues building in the past, we strongly encourage you to buy tokens in advance of the day.** You will be able to buy tokens in the following quantities:

Cost	Tokens	+ free	Total tokens
25p	1	0	1
£1.00	4	0	4
£5.00	20	0	20
£10.00	40	2	42
£20.00	80	4	84

### Can I buy tokens on the day of the fayre?

- Yes, you can buy tokens on the day of the fayre, using cash as payment. You will need to buy these from the canopy outside the main entrance.

#### How do I use tokens in the fayre?

- Every token is worth 25p, so one token will buy you one game in the hall. If you'd like to buy baking priced at 50p, for example, this will use two tokens. To buy a strip of raffle tickets at £1, this will use four tokens. This means that we will not have to give out change.

**The only stalls that will take cash or card payments on the day will be the independent stalls that are not run by school.**
