New Building at Watercliffe Meadow

This week work will begin on our bottom MUGA on a new building that will create a provision for children with special educational needs at Watercliffe Meadow and the local area. Details of how the provision will be run are still being worked on with colleagues from services in education, health and care but it is an exciting development for Watercliffe and for Sheffield.

A proposal was put forward almost 2 years ago by our governors. The building is being built and funded through Sheffield City Council and the plan is that work will be completed before the end of the summer holidays.

Between now and then the work will be self-contained on one half of the MUGA and will have minimal impact on the day to day running of school.

As details of the provision are finalised, we will share them with you. In the meantime, we will try to answer any questions that you may have.
