Magna Aqua Park Visit

To enjoy the aqua park fully, **children need to bring a change of clothes**, this could be swim wear or PE kit and they must bring a small towel (we won't have spares). Please also send your child with a spare plastic bag to put wet clothes in. Children will have to carry this, as well as their lunch so as little extra weight as possible is best.

Lunch Arrangements	A healthy packed lunch with a drink (no glass bottles). Children who are entitled to income based free school meals will be provided with a pick and mix by the school.
Other Information	Please ensure your child wears their uniform and a rucksack to carry their packed lunch (even if they have ordered a pick and mix), towel and swimwear and spare plastic bag to put wet clothes in. Please apply/send sun cream if the weather is sunny.
