**The Smoothie Bike:** An exciting opportunity for adults to pedal a specialised stationary bicycle to blend up a delicious, fresh fruit smoothie!

**Free Refreshments:** We will be serving complimentary fresh fruit for families, kindly provided by our local Tesco store under their Free Fruit and Veg for Schools Scheme.
