Dear Families of children in Year 2

Year 2 - Two Night Residential Visit 2023

We are excited to offer our Y2 children the chance of a 2 night residential to Whiteley Woods Outdoor Activities Centre. This is owned by the Girlguiding charity and we have used the site now for the last 2 years. We have booked the Renwick building for the week of **16th to 20th October 2023**. The week will be split, with each of the two Y2 classes being able to stay for two nights:

Mrs Morton's class will visit **16th to 18th October**

Mrs Read's class will visit **18th to 20th October**

The total cost for this residential visit is **£40.00** per child. This includes transport, the cost of accommodation and food. This residential visits is limited to 24 places per class, as this is the maximum number of children Whiteley Woods can accommodate. Due to the sleeping arrangements this needs to be 12 boys and 12 girls. Places will be given on a first come first served basis to those who pay the £10 deposit (or set up a Payment Plan). Any outstanding debts to school must be paid before a place can be booked. The last day for booking is **Friday 29th September with a £10 deposit**.

The easiest way to book your place and pay the £10 deposit is on the School Gateway app. If you are not registered on this please contact school on office@watercliffe.sheffield.sch.uk. The remaining £30 needs to be paid by **Friday 6th October** to keep your place and this can also be done on the School Gateway app.

Alternatively you could set up a payment plan for your child – a lot of parents have this in place already for their family. To enquire about this please email us on office@watercliffe.sheffield.sch.uk

So that you can find out more about what we have planned we have arranged a meeting after school on **Tuesday 26th September at 5.00pm** in the Hall. At the meeting we will provide more details about the visit and give you the chance to ask any questions you may have.
